

Muncie Sailing Club Major Club Rules, Concerns, and Courtesies

- Membership in the Muncie Sailing Club includes persons in the member's immediate family, or two adults sharing a household, and the member's dependent children.
- Boats moored at the docks shall not exceed 27 ft. L.O.A., 9 ft. 4 in. beam, and 5000 lb. displacement.
- Boats moored at buoys shall not exceed 23 ft. L.O.A. and 2500 lb. displacement.
- Boats assigned a mooring slip must be in by July 15 or the space is forfeited the following year, unless the Harbormaster has given permission for a later launching.
- Guests of members are allowed only when the member is present. Adult children of members are categorized as guests.
- Guests cannot bring their own boats, without prior Board approval. All applicable City fees must be paid.
- Club lock combinations must not be shared with guests (non-members).
- The numbers on the padlocks should be scrambled immediately after opening the lock. This will reduce the probability of outsiders learning the lock combinations.
- The operation of boats other than sailboats, tenders, or Club boats is not allowed.
- Powerboats other than the Club boats are not allowed at the docks. Launching of powerboats, even by Club members, is not permitted from the Club ramp.
- Fishing is not permitted from the docks or seawall.
- Parking on the seawall is prohibited. Loading and unloading is permitted, but vehicles should then be immediately taken to one of the parking areas. If a passenger has difficulty walking from the parking area, it is preferred that s/he be dropped off at the docks and then the car parked in the parking area.
- All boats must be removed from the lower dry sail area prior to Fall Dock Day and from MSC property within 30 days of Fall Dock Day.
- Secure the house when you leave unless others are in the house.
- Remember that the house and facilities are there for the entire Membership.
